- SYNOPSIS
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1.- Synopsis:

The philosopher Walter Benjamin tried to escape the Nazi advance in 1940 by crossing the border between France and Spain on foot. His escape ended in suicide. The route he followed between Banyuls and Portbou has since been named the Way Walter Benjamin, and is traveled every year by hundreds of pilgrims who come to honor his memory along with that of other exiles: that of the Republican side after Franco's coup in Spain, that of so many fleeing Nazi barbarism in the Second World War. The documentary “Walter Benjamin, the aura of the path” is the story of this route, a story of historical memory, a reflection on exile and Benjamin's thought.

My creative work is based on the intersection of image, text and sound, constructed in a synchronic way, as an audiovisual composition. In my videography the narratives are often abstract or experimental; in others, closer to the documentary genre, the plot assumes a dramatic development.

My work have been presented in different spaces and contexts, both in the artistic tradition such as museums and galleries, as well as in the cinematographic tradition: festivals, cinemas and programming in different TV channels.
